# What Happens in a Crisis?

## **Description:**

This simulation will help youth understand the complexities of hunger and poverty in the US, its emotional and physical consequences and what can happen in a crisis situation.

### **Objectives:**

Youth will better understand:

- 1. The definition and relationship between poverty, hunger and food distribution.
- 2. How families end up in need in the US society.
- 3. What happens to families in crisis.
- 4. The emotional ramifications of being food insecure in our country.

#### Time:

About 20-30 minutes

#### **Materials and Preparation:**

Access to YouTube and video screen appropriate for whatever size group you have. Question handout for each participant.

#### Plan:

- 1. Watch each 2-minute Feeding America video profiling individuals:

- 2. After each video consider the discussion and thought questions on the handout.
- 3. Discussion, as a group, the ramifications of a crisis on families in need based on these stories.
